Purpose: The Cotsen Institute of Archaeology offers fellowships for undergraduate students who are involved in an archaeological field school or research project, preferably with a UCLA professor. This competitive program is based on a student's academic record and financial need. Apart from overall academic excellence, your statement should show a commitment to field research. The fellowship is meant to defray costs of participation in an archaeological field project, but some exceptions to the off-campus rule may be permitted.

Eligibility: Undergraduate students from any department on campus are eligible, as long as they are in good academic standing. Students not preparing for a career in archaeology are also urged to apply.
