

## Archaeology IDP Plan of Study Template

All applicants must fill out a plan of study outlining projected coursework at UCLA. The plan of study assists the admissions committee with identifying applicants' primary interests and potential connections to faculty and programs at UCLA.

The plan of study should be uploaded via the admissions application portal.

All students in the program must take the core course sequence (Archaeology M201A-M201C) during their first year. They must also complete a course outside of their regional focus and two laboratory courses as part of their required coursework, which is usually completed during the first two years in the program. Students without an MA must complete a minimum of 42 units and at least 9 courses (most courses are four units) before they complete the MA portion of our program. Students with an MA from another institution must complete the required courses listed below, including the core sequence, but there is no minimum number of courses required for students with an MA.
